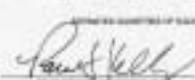

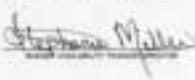

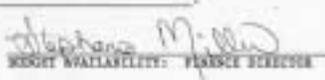

**DISCUSS NEW ZONING  
REGULATIONS**

Councilman Jackson stated the following: "As you know, later this month the Planning Commission will be taking for study a new zoning code and map for the City of Cookeville. I am concerned that there may be a rush of building permit applications and rezoning requests in the next few months in an attempt to circumvent the new codes before they are adopted. One of the most significant aspects of the new zoning code deals with changes in the location of new multi-family residential developments, which has been a major concern of this Council. Also, it is not logical for the city to be considering individual rezoning requests at the same time we will be considering a new map which changes the zoning for the entire city.
