SUBJ: Emergency Pump Repair – Water Plant

Raw water pump #4 at our Water Treatment Plant recently shut down by tripping the motor overload. The unit was checked out by our electrician and he did not find anything wrong that he thought would cause the pump to shut down. We placed the unit back into service. A week later the pump shut itself down again and this time we discovered that a bottom guide bearing was starting to fail.

This is one of two high capacity pumps located at our raw water intake. Since we were left with only one high capacity pump in operation we had John Bouchard, a large pump repair firm, come up and inspect the pump. They recommended pulling the pump and replacing both the top and lower bearings. We also requested that they clean and inspect the rest of the unit while it was out. We instructed them to begin the repairs immediately since we were left with only one high capacity pump at our intake.

The repairs have been completed and I will be presenting the request for payment during the next City Council meeting. The cost of these repairs totaled \$8,500.


