





**SUBJ:** Change Order – System-Wide SCADA System Contract

On December 10, 2009 the City Council approved a contract with M/R Systems for the purchase and installation of a system wide SCADA system. The new SCADA system would replace an old system that was installed in the 80's and only monitored the wastewater pumping stations. The new SCADA system would allow our department to monitor all wastewater pumping stations and all water tanks.

We have requested the contractor provide us with a price for the recommended spare parts for the new SCADA system. Since all of our RTU's (remote transmitting units) are virtually identical, our number of spare parts is limited. The contractor has provided us with a quote of \$6,852.79. This contract increase can be added to our current SRF Loan amount, which would allow us to benefit from the 50% principal forgiveness. The new contract amount, including this change order, will be \$364,508.79. I recommend approval of this change order.


