Separate sealed Bids for furnishing of all materials, labor, tools, equipment, and appliances necessary for the "Water Treatment Plant – Cleaning of Sludge Lagoons" will be received by the Owner at the Department of Water Quality Control, 1860 S. Jefferson Ave., Cookeville, TN 38506, until 3:00 p.m., local time, on Thursday, June 25, 2015, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

The Project consists of the following major elements: cleaning, dewatering, hauling, and disposal of contents (sludge, scum sediment, etc.) of two 1.0-acre, two-million-gallon sludge lagoons. Estimate total quantity of material to be disposed of is approximately 1,500 dry tons.

All Bidders must be licensed contractors as required by the Contractor's Licensing Act of 1976 of the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee, and qualified for the type of work being bid upon.

Each bidder must deposit with his bid, security in the amount, form and subject to the conditions provided in the information for Bidders.

Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirement of TCA 50-9-133 regarding Drug-free workplace and TCA 12-3-309, Certificate of Compliance regarding Illegal Immigrants.

The City of Cookeville reserves the right to waive any irregularities or reject any or all bids as deemed in the best interest of the City, and to re-advertise the project as necessary.
